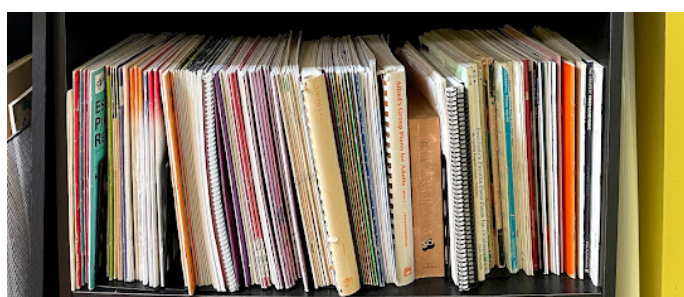
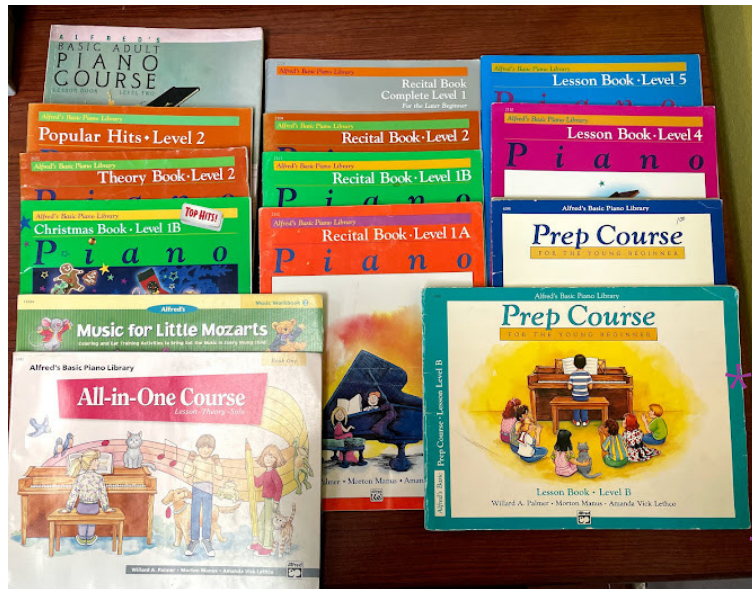


# Spreading the Music

### Alfred Books

- \*Best piano book for adults\*
- \*Theory based\*
- \*Fully progresses upwards\*
- \*slightly more Christian religious music\*
- \*preferred over Faber books\*



### Faber Books

- \*slower paced\*
- \*Doesn't introduced BH until last page\* (Technique and Artistry Primer Level)
- \*Repeated melodies for LH\*
- \*good for parents who want to help students\*
- \*lesson books pair well with theory books\*



### Bastien Books

- \*Great for imaginative students\*
- \*letter name based\*
- \*the music is more cultural\*
- \*does not pay much attention to the relationship between notes like Alfred\*
- \*incredible sight reading strategies for placing students\*



### Snell Books

- \*Strictly classical
- \*Gradually progresses\*
- \*Has the hits like Fur Elise and Minuet in G\*
- \*17, 18, 19 Century music\*
